



## Perugia

Pebbled Grain Textured Leather

**Average Hide Size:** 55 s.f.

**Average Thickness:** 1.1 mm

**Average Weight:** 3.25 oz.

Traditionally popular in Europe, Perugia owes its popularity to its heavy, grainy texture and unexpectedly natural, soft hand. Perugia is created from heavy full-grain hides, which are aniline dyed and then dry-milled in a rotating drum, a process that results in a natural break, or pebbled effect, in the surface. While lesser-quality textured leathers may be embossed with a faux “leather” pattern, resulting in a stiff and uniform appearance, Perugia’s texture, created in the drum, seems to come alive with depth and variation.
