



## Rodeo

Paraffin, Distressed Pull-up Leather

**Average Hide Size:** 50 s.f.

**Average Thickness:** 1.0 mm

**Average Weight:** 2.75 oz

In response to numerous requests for a “distressed” upholstery leather, Cortina has developed Rodeo. These pure aniline, full-grain hides are treated with an application of paraffin and then dry-milled to produce a cozy, comfortable look. The quintessential comfort leather, Rodeo’s timeless, aged appearance has a warm, inviting touch. Its surface will lighten and darken with use, and will become more distressed with time, part of what makes this leather so attractive. Because Rodeo is considered “naked” leather with the minimum amount of protection, Rodeo is meant to scuff, stain and fade so that it appears more worn with use, the hallmark of “distressed” leathers.
