Meaning “velvet” in Italian, Velluto is the “velvet of leather,” a rich and lush cowsuede imbued with pure, deep aniline dyes. Cowsuede is the center horizontal split of a hide, smaller yet thicker in weight, with the protections and durability necessary for upholstery applications. Cortina stocks this hard-to-find specialty leather in 11 distinctive colors. Because the average hide is only 16 s.f., Velluto is ideal for small seats, pillows and welting. Velluto is less protected against staining than a non-suede leather so it is not recommended for use in proximity to food, in high-traffic areas or public spaces.
